| Classification | Type of garbage | collection date | Specifics & Points for Disposal |
|--------------------|--------------------------------|-----------------|---|
| | Burnable | Twice a Week | <p>Please cut it to less than 1 meter</p> <p>Please remove the filth</p> <p>Less than 50 cm in length & 6 cm in thickness</p> <p>Safety shoes are "Non-Burnable."</p> <p>Put it in a garbage bag specified by the city, should be tied it tightly and put it out.</p> <p>45L: 500 yen (Pack of 10) 20L: 300 yen (Pack of 10) 10L: 200 yen (Pack of 10)</p> <p>Be sure to drain kitchen waste.</p> <p>Garbage too large to fit in a 45 L bag is "Oversized Garbage."</p> |
| | | Twice a Month | <p>Garbage must be small enough to be put in a cage of the Collection Station.</p> <p>Knives and broken glasses should be put out wrapped in paper, less dangerously.</p> <p>Garbage should be put out only on the recyclable garbage collection day.</p> |
| Recyclable garbage | Empty Cans | | <p>Paint cans and the like are "Non-Burnable."</p> |
| | Empty Bottles | | <p>3 divisions !</p> <p>Colorless Bottles</p> <p>Brown Bottles</p> <p>Bottles of other colors</p> <p>Drinks, bottles other than food, broken bottles, those not made of glass are "Non-burnable."</p> |
| | Pet Bottles | | <p>Soiled bottles must be put out as "Burnable."</p> |
| | Plastic Containers & Wrappings | Twice a Month | <p>Put out in transparent bags.</p> <p>Dirty items should be put as "Burnable."</p> |
| | Used paper | | <p>4 divisions !</p> <p>Books, Magazines, Paper bags, Wrapping paper, Copying paper, etc.</p> <p>The silver packed paper pack is "burnable."</p> <p>Other paper</p> |
| | Used Clothing | | <p>Raincoats, Hats, Caps, Muffler, Underwear, etc are "Burnable."</p> |
| | Small Household Appliances | | <p>Please remove kerosene</p> <p>Size of the items must be small enough to be put in a Collection Cage.</p> <p>Batteries must be removed.</p> <p>Data on personal computers and mobile phones are erased</p> |
| | Mercury | | <p>Broken fluorescent lamps are "Non-burnable."</p> <p>Please put the fluorescent lamp in a box container so that it will not break.</p> <p>Thermometers and mirrors, even broken, still contain "Mercury."</p> |
| | Oversized Garbage | Twice a Year | <p>less than 2 m in length & 15 cm in thickness</p> <p>Regardless of size</p> |

Non-sorted Garbage is not collected. Please follow the "Separation Rules."

| Uncollectable garbage | <p>【 Items subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Law 】</p> <p>【 How to Dispose of these items: 】</p> <p>① Have the shop that purchased the item take over the item.</p> <p>② In the case of a replacement, have it taken over by a newly purchased shop.</p> <p>③ Ask the garbage collector.</p> <p>④ Take them to the designated place for yourself. (Purchase a Home Appliance Recycle Card at a Post Office.)</p> | <p>【 Other 】</p> |
| | <p>【 As for the items set up by particular agents, ask them to dispose. 】</p> | |
